## Opera and Olive Oil Are on the Menu At the Gables Inn for Sunday Brunch

n Dec. 9, as an accompaniment to its ever-popular Sunday brunch, the Gables Inn bed and breakfast in Beach Haven presents the Italian operatic vocal stylings of award-winning musician Michéal Castaldo and a tasting of his signature line of extra-virgin olive oils, harvested from the Castaldo family's grove in Calabria.

He will deliver three performances on Sunday, at 10 a.m., noon and 2 p.m., all of which are free and open to the public, as is the tasting of the olive oils, which will be served with fresh bread. In addition to its usual brunch menu, which includes organic eggs Benedict and French toast soufflé, the Gables will offer some special Italian dishes for the occasion, Beninati said.

The Gables continues to be open on weekends through the end of the year, when New York City's Jay Ditammo and his band will lead the New Year's Eve celebration in music. After a six-week hiatus, the bed and breakfast will reopen in time for Valentine's Day.
